 - (b) GrandPre's is a courtyard performance area. In the event of rain, shows will be relocated, if possible, to Marcer Manor, 1000 N Rampart. If not possible, advance ticket purchases will be refunded on the spot.
 - (c) Our children's programming is at "Seelos Hall," an outbuilding of Blessed Francis Xavier Seelos Parish, 3037 Dauphine. You will not be able to map "Seelos Hall." PLEASE NOTE THE KID'S SHOWS START TIMES.
 - (d) The Garret, also not mappable, is a second floor space above NOLA Shaolin-Do, 4210 St Claude. Look for the back corner entrance on the France Avenue side of the dojo.
